Arrange your own space with a setup that works for your audiovisual presentation needs

Practice! Practice! Practice!

Practice using the platform to familiarize yourself with the technology and to ensure smooth transitions





Present your BEST self



Have a professional appearance, background, and comportment

Embrace your online teaching persona

Your online teaching persona may be slightly different from your in-person teaching style. That's OK!

Set ground rules with learners

- Make sure expectations are clear from the start
- Define "netiquette"
- Mute unless speaking
- Develop methods on how to "raise hands"

Promote learner engagement

Use chat, polls, cold-calling techniques



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Be mindful of Virtual Space Logistics

- Leave more time for attendees to answer questions
- Consider group size, composition and timing in
- advance for breakout rooms
- Designate breakout room leads/recorders and structured exercises



Foster a culture of accountability

- Don't lose your learners in virtual space
- Encourage all to contribute to ensure engagement
- Camera on = more engaged state
- Cold-call consistently so learners understand it is a part of the process and to be expected

Develop a Communication Plan



Distance learning can be confusing & isolating Messaging in online courses can be overwhelming

- A communication plan can clarify expectations & reduce noise

 A plan should include communication modality and expected response time

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Use asynchronous learning tools

- Prerecording lessons to watch before hand to promote in-class discussions (engagement)
- Move didactic materials to out-of-class for asynchronous, self-paced learning
- Set up structured ways for engagement out of class (collaborative editing of documents, etc)



Be forgiving of yourself

- You are bound to make mistakes
- Embrace errors
- Mistakes enable opportunities for growth
- Make small changes, assess and refine

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
